Forecast Highlights


- The heaviest snow has ended.
- Today
 - Steady snow will continue across western and central MN.
 - Mainly rain expected elsewhere.
- Monday Night/Tuesday
 - Light snow/ice possible as temperatures fall below freezing.
 - Another 1-2" of snow possible.
 - Wet roads may become slick!
 - Easterly winds will become northwesterly at 30 to 40 mph.

Impacts

Travel is the primary impact.

• No significant changes.






Winter Storm Warnings

 The Winter Storm Warning times vary by location. Please check the local expiration time for your area at weather.gov








Monday - Tuesday Winds

Forecast Details

- Easterly winds become northeasterly and eventually northwesterly as the storm exits the region.
- Most blowing snow concerns are confined to when it is actively snowing across western and central Minnesota.






Monday - Tuesday Temperatures






Tonight into Tuesday Morning - Ice Potential

Forecast Details

- There is a chance for a couple hours of a wintry mix of sleet and freezing rain Monday Night into Tuesday morning as temperatures fall below freezing.
- A glazing of ice is possible in the yellow-shaded regions.






Wednesday Temperatures

 Much colder temperatures are expected overnight Tuesday into Wednesday, which could lead to a flash freeze scenario following the last few days of wet weather.
