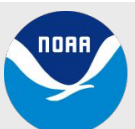


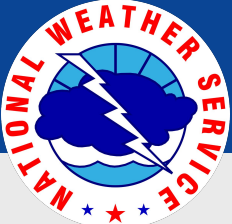

- The **Winter Storm Warning** times vary by location. Please check the local expiration time for your area at weather.gov



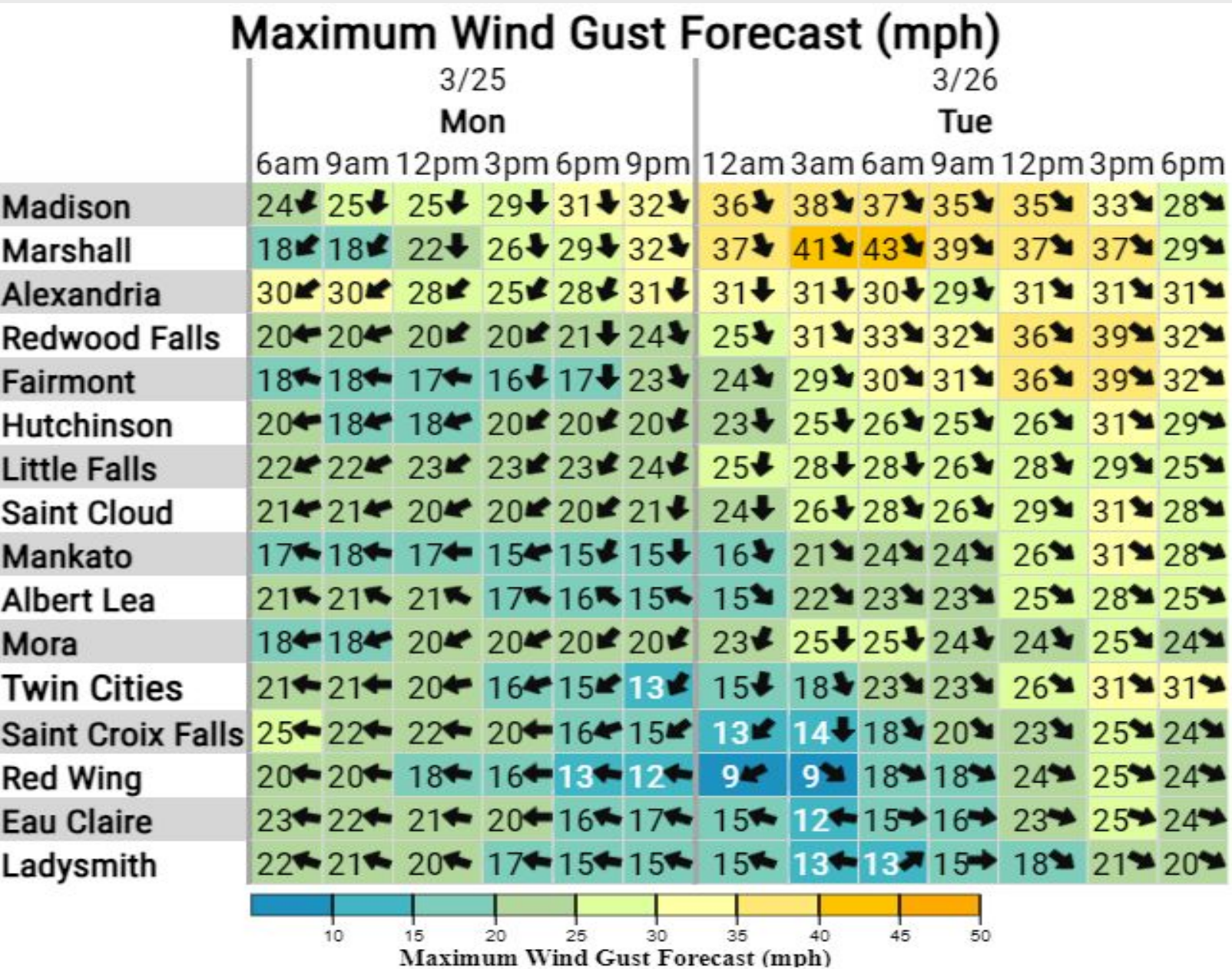


Monday - Tuesday Winds

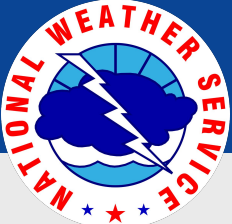
Forecast Details

- Most blowing snow concerns are confined to when it is actively snowing across western and central Minnesota.

(Sorted geographically from West to East)



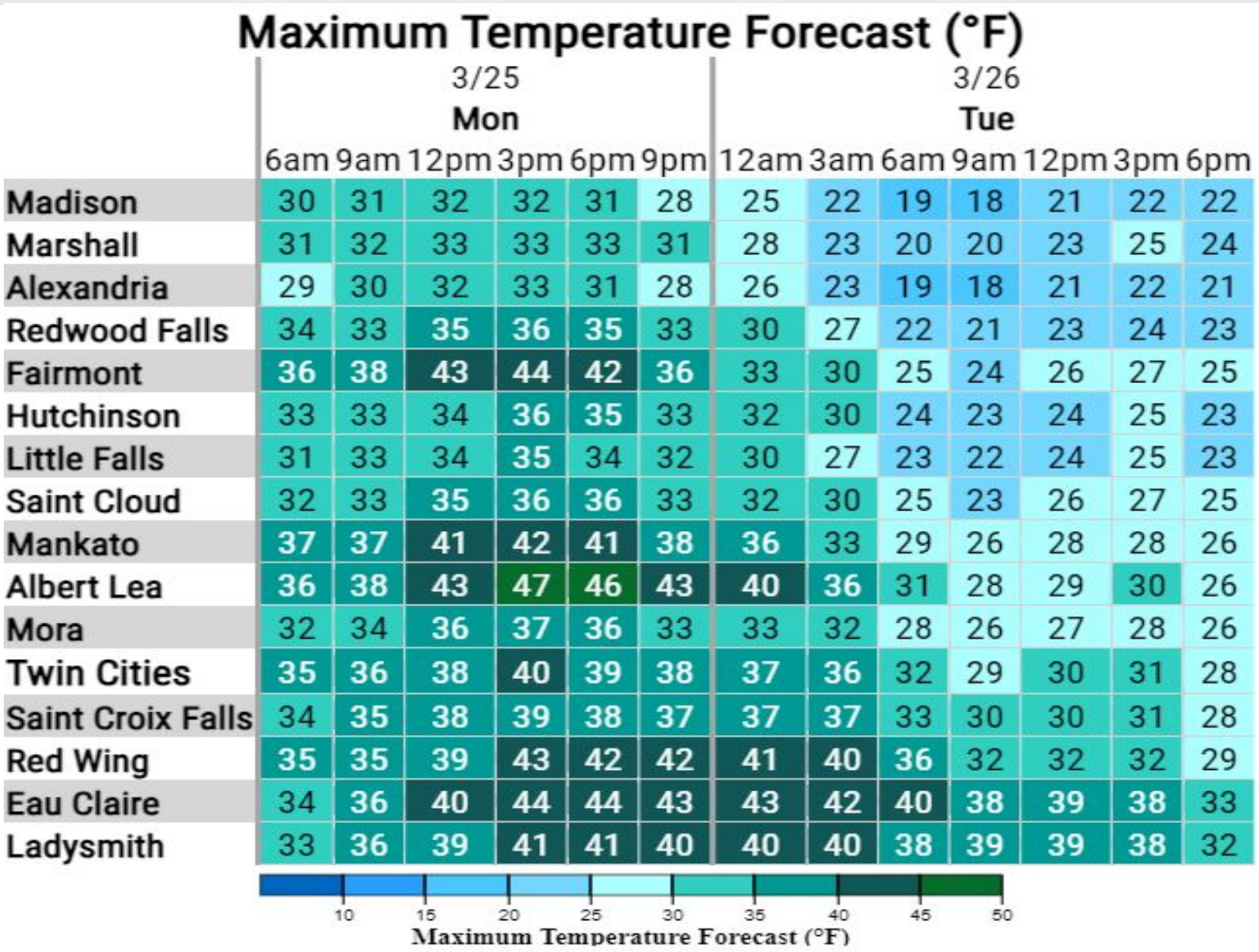


Monday - Tuesday Temperatures

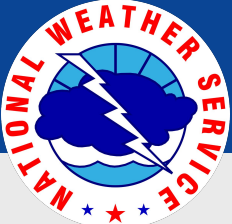
Forecast Details

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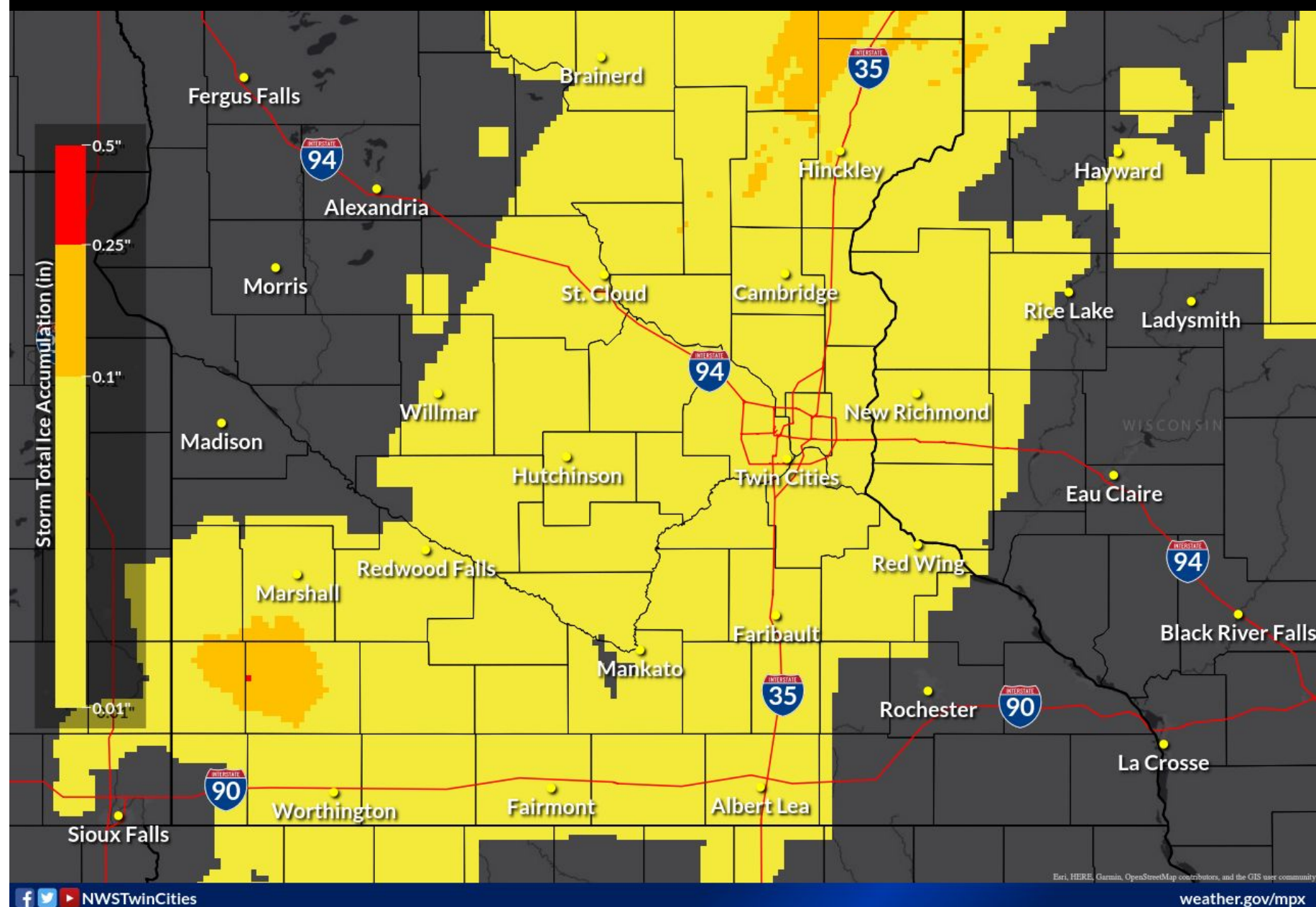
Tonight into Tuesday Morning - Ice Potential

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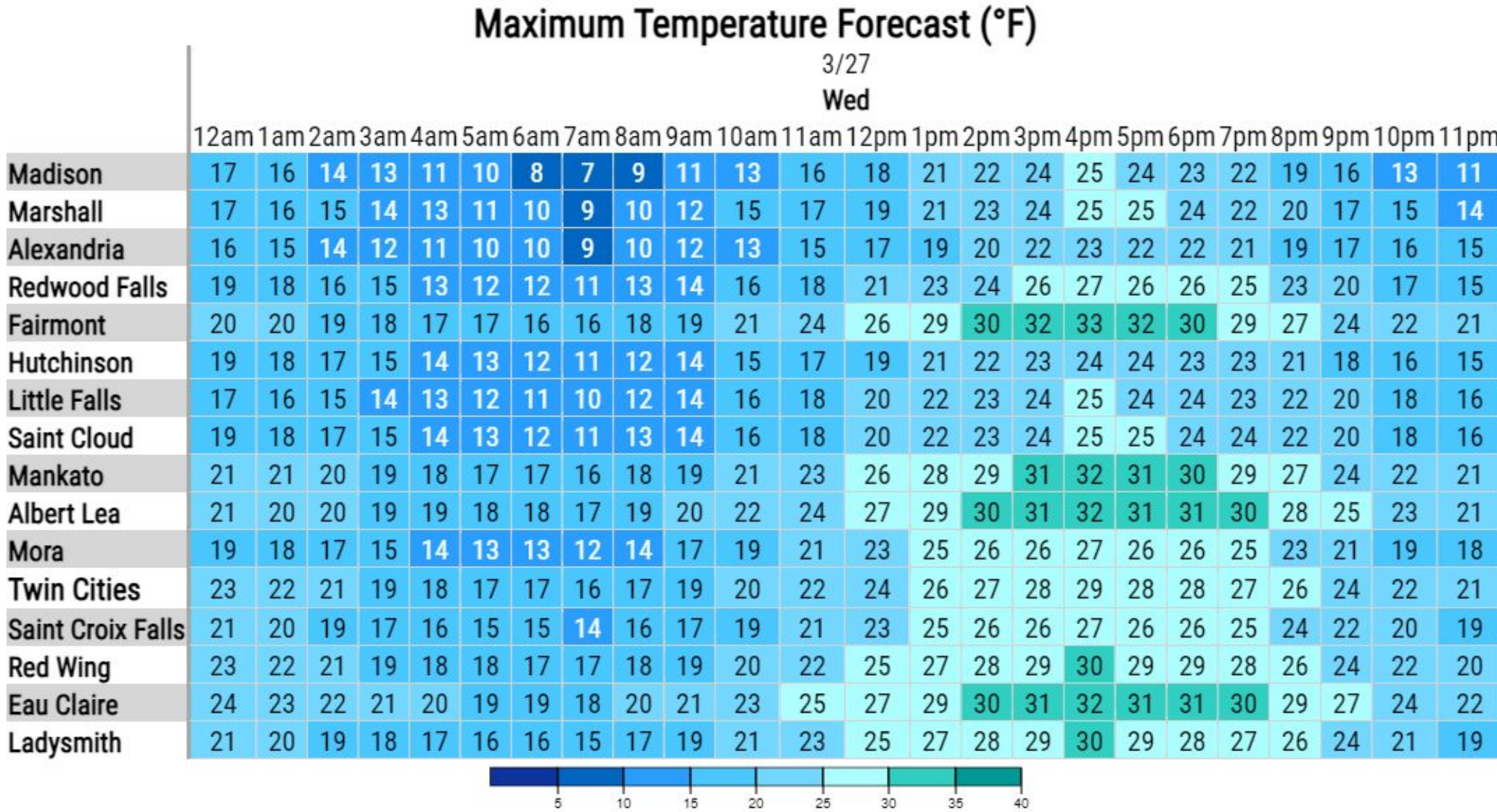


Wednesday Temperatures

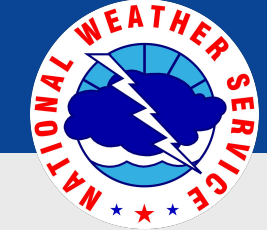
Forecast Details

- Much colder temperatures are expected overnight Tuesday into Wednesday, which could lead to a flash freeze scenario following the last few days of wet weather.



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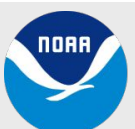
